Tournament Rules

- 1.) Players must compete in their own grade classification, with the exception that players in a lower grade may participate in an older division. A player may only play on one team per grade.
- 2.) Basketballs: Bring your own warm-up basketballs. Game balls will be provided.
- 3.) No zone defenses
- 4.) 5th, 6th, and 7th grade may press in the final 2 minutes of the game.
- 5.) There will be two – 14 minute running time halves. The clock will stop only for the last 2 minutes of the game for dead balls and free throws.
- 6.) Warm up time will be influenced by starting time. If games are behind schedule, a 5 minute warm-up time will be used. There will be a 3 minute half time.
- 7.) Overtime will be two minutes with the clock stopping as in regular play. Teams will be allowed one extra time-out for the overtime period. If a second overtime is needed, sudden victory will be applied, the first team to score 2 points is the winner.
- 8.) Fouls – players are allowed five fouls. Free-throws will be shot after shooting fouls with the bonus in effect after the 7th team foul in a half. 2 shots awarded after the 10th team foul in a half. Ejection will occur after the 2nd technical foul of an individual in the tournament. **All other MSHSL League Rules apply.**
- 9.) Timeouts: Two timeouts per half (no carryover)
- 10.) Breckenridge Public Schools/Breckenridge Community Education/Cowgirl Basketball Booster Club are not responsible for lost articles or valuables.
- 11.) Three games are guaranteed. A forfeit is considered a guaranteed game.
- 12.) There will be an admission fee for adults and students. Coaches and players get free admission. Concessions will be available.
- 13.) 10 medals will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams in each bracket.
- 14.) Pairings, game sites and times will be emailed the Monday of the week of the tournament.
- 15.) Running time will be implemented after a 20 point lead.
- 16.) Tie Breaker: Head to Head and then Total points
- 17.) ALL REFEREE DECISIONS ARE FINAL (All adult referees.)
- 18.) **Registration DEADLINE is Friday, January 7th**
Teams should arrive 15 minutes before their scheduled game time.
